1. ENTRY FEE

- a. Team Entry Fee shall be \$750.
- b. A non-refundable deposit of \$150.00 must accompany your entry to guarantee your spot. See Rule 7 for more details.
- c. Checks should be made payable to KingPins and will be accepted up to 2 weeks prior to the tournament. All other payments must be by credit/debit card or cash. Final Payment must be made no later than 8:45am on Saturday, July 20th. If paying on tournament day, you must pay in cash.
- d. Payout shall be in 1:3 teams. If all 24 spots are full, pay down 8 places.
- e. Lineage/Expenses \$6,480. High Game Pots \$600. Prize Fund \$14,420.

2. FORMAT

- a. Teams will consist of 5 bowlers with a minimum 1 man, 1 woman, and 1 senior (a senior must be a bowler 50 years of age as of the tournament date and is separate from the 1 man/1 woman requirement), and 2 other bowlers of any mix.
- b. Teams will bowl two 6 game blocks. First block will be bowled at KingPins Portland on Saturday July 20th, 2024. Second block will be bowled at KingPins Beaverton on Sunday July 21st, 2024.
 - i. KingPins Portland is located at 3550 SE 92nd Ave, Portland, OR 97266
 - ii. KingPins Beaverton is located at 2725 SW Cedar Hills Blvd, Beaverton, OR 97005
- c. Each game will be a position round. Total points will determine each position; all ties will be broken by pinfall. The first round will be set by a random draw for starting positions.
- 3. POINTS 7 points possible per game. Points will be awarded on an individual and team bases as follows:
 - a. One point will be awarded to the winner of each individual game.
 - b. Two points will be awarded to the winning team (based on total pins)
 - c. Total points will determine the Tournament Champions. In the case of a tie, total pinfall will be the deciding factor.

4. ENTERING AVERAGES

- a. Entering team maximum average is 1040.
- b. Use 2022-2023 Bowl.com highest average of 45 games or more (includes verifiable Canadian Tenpin Federation rule 319f). If none, then we will use current highest league average as of June 1, 2024 with a minimum 45 games (average verification must accompany entry). If none, we will go back to 2021-2022 verifiable average of 30 games or more. If none of these options can be met, men and senior will enter with 225, and women with 210.
- c. There is one average break of 225 allowed per team. To clarify, you may have 1 bowler on your team with an average over 225, which is not a touring PBA member, that may come in with an entering average of 225.
- d. The minimum entering average is 160. To clarify, you may have bowlers on your team that average less than 160, but they must use an entering average of 160.
- e. No more than one touring PBA member per team, must use 230 as an average. A touring PBA member means any bowler that participates in a PBA or PBA50 National Tour event, regional events excluded.
- f. Failure to use the correct average will disqualify a team if the correct averages cause the team to exceed 1040 maximum.
- g. The tournament director reserves the right to re-rate any bowler.
- h. USBC Rule 319a, item 2 '10-pin average increase,' will not apply.

a. Saturday July 20th, 9:00am start time (8:45am practice)
 b. Sunday July 21st, 9:00am start time (8:45am practice)

6. TEAM LINE-UPS

- a. Your team line-up is due 2 weeks prior to the tournament date. Team captains will have the option on each tournament day to change their line-up, all changes must be completed by the end of practice time.
- b. Team line-ups submitted for the first game will be used for games 1-6. A lineup change will be allowed before game 7 (1st game of Sunday's block) and that lineup will be used for games 7-12.
- c. Once competition has begun, substitutes are allowed but must bowl in the same position of the bowler that is being replaced and their average must fit within the team maximum, and will continue for the remaining block. At all times, a team must comply with Rule 2(a).
- d. Late bowlers will start in the frame they arrive while receiving a "0" for each missed frame.

7. SECURING TEAM SPOT

- a. Space is limited to 24 teams. Team Captains from the previous year's Swiss will be contacted in February 2024 and given the right of first refusal, provided they pay their deposit by March 4th, 2024. On March 16th, any openings will be first come, first served.
- b. A non-refundable deposit of \$150.00 must accompany your entry to guarantee your spot. Accepting deposits for remaining open spots as of March 16th, 2024.
