## KINGPINS CROWN THE LANES **TOURNAMENT SERIES RULES**

ELIGIBILITY - Youth Scholarship Tournament is open to all 2024-2025 Youth League Bowlers. (Gene Cole on May 4th is open to all KingPins Youth League Bowlers) All bowlers must be USBC youth members in good standing. Non-USBC bowlers may purchase a sanction card for \$4 on the day of the tournament.

ENTRY FEE - Entry fee per tournament is \$25 per bowler (\$12 for lineage and \$13 for scholarship). First place scholarship of \$200, Second Place \$100, Third place \$75, will be guaranteed for each division. Tournaments open for entry on the day of the previous tournament in the series.

ENTERING AVERAGE - Use the highest league average of current season with 21 games or more. If none then use highest book average from 2023-2024. If none the highest average of the Platinum division will be used. Averages will be taken as of the Sunday leading up to the tournament date.

DIVISIONS - There will be four divisions. Competition in all divisions is handicap based on 90% of 220. Platinum 200+ (Scratch), Gold 160-199, Silver 120-159 and Bronze 119 or less.

FORMAT - Participants will bowl three game tournament format and move one pair to the right after each game. Highest pin fall with handicap will determine the champion of each division. The top three bowlers in each division will advance to a stepladder finals based on the three games of qualifying (dependent upon number of entries). The third place qualifier will bowl a one game match against the second place qualifier with the winner advancing to bowl a one game match against the tournament leader. Matches will be bowled in a match play format alternating frames. The higher qualifier in each match will have choice of starting lane. This is based on the number of entries in each division.

TOURNAMENT ATTIRE - No hats of any kind may be worn during tournament play. All participants are required to wear a collar shirt or jersey with dress pants, dress shorts or skorts. No sweatpants or gym pants/shorts. The tournament director will have the final authority to determine the appropriateness of any clothing worn by any participant and to disqualify any participant if deemed necessary.

**DISPUTES -** Any issue not specifically covered in these rules will be governed by USBC rules. The tournament director will have the final authority on all disputes.

SCHOLARSHIPS - All scholarship winnings will be forwarded to the USBC's SMART program under account #9688 for management and distribution.
