# KINGPINS TOURNAMENT SERIES RULES

**ELIGIBILITY** - Youth Scholarship Tournament is open to all 2025-2026 Youth League Bowlers. All bowlers must be USBC youth members in good standing. Non-USBC bowlers may purchase a sanction card for \$4 on Bowl.com prior to the tournament.

**ENTRY FEE** - Entry fee per tournament is \$30 per bowler (\$12 for lineage and \$18 for scholarship). First place scholarship of \$150, Second Place \$100, Third Place \$50, will be guaranteed for each division. Registration is now open for all tournaments. Entries accepted until the Sunday before the tournament.

**ENTERING AVERAGE** - Use the highest league average of current season with 21 games or more. If none then use highest book average from 2024-2025. If none the highest average of the Gold division will be used. Averages will be taken as of the Sunday leading up to the tournament date.

**DIVISIONS** - There will be three divisions. Competition in the divisions handicap is based on 90% of 220. Gold 175+, Silver 140-174 and Bronze 139 or less.

**FORMAT** - Participants will bowl three game qualifiers. The top three bowlers in each division will advance to a stepladder finals based on the three games of qualifying (dependent upon number of entries). The third place qualifier will bowl a one game match against the second place qualifier with the winner advancing to bowl a one game match against the tournament leader. The higher qualifier in each match will have choice of starting lane. This is based on the number of entries in each division. The bowler on the left lane will bowl first and bowlers will alternate frames.

**TOURNAMENT ATTIRE** - No hats of any kind may be worn during tournament play. All participants are required to wear a collar shirt or jersey with dress pants, dress shorts or skorts. No sweatpants or gym pants/shorts. The tournament director will have the final authority to determine the appropriateness of any clothing worn by any participant and to disqualify any participant if deemed necessary.

**DISPUTES** - Any issue not specifically covered in these rules will be governed by USBC rules. The tournament director will have the final authority on all disputes.

**SCHOLARSHIPS** - All scholarship winnings will be forwarded to the USBC's SMART program under account #14521 for management and distribution.
